ABOUT VIDYA BHARTI

Vidya Bharati is providing quality education since 1952 and is committed to educating the young generation according to Bhartiya values and culture. Some committed and patriotic people, who considered education as an artifice to educate the young generation according to Bhartiya values and culture started the first school in Gorakhpur, UP, in 1952. They named this school as Saraswati Shishu Mandir-Temple of the Goddess Saraswati dedicated to the children. Thanks to their zeal, dedication, and hard work that similar schools began to be established in other places also. The number of such schools increased rapidly in Uttar Pradesh. A state-level Shishu Shiksha Prabandh Samiti was formed in 1958 for their proper guidance and planned development. Good education & sound sanskaras at the Saraswati Shishu Mandirs earned recognition, honor, and popularity in the society. Shishu Mandirs started spreading in other states and within a few years, many schools were established. To manage the affairs in different regions, state-level committees were set up. The formation of a national body came in 1977 and Vidya Bharati - Akhil Bharatiya Shiksha Sansthan was established with its Registered office at Lucknow & Functional Headquarters in Delhi. All state-level committees were affiliated to this Vidya Bharati Akhil Bharatiya Shiksha Sansthan.

ABOUT KURUKSHETRA UNIVERSITY

The Kurukshetra University was established in 1956 as a unitary residential University and its foundation stone was laid by late Dr. Rajendra Prasad, the first President of India. Located in the holy city of Kurukshetra, land of the historical battle of 'Mahabharata' and the great message of Bhagwad Gita, its campus is situated on the western bank of BrahmSarovar (the holy tank) and extends over an area of over 400 acres. Starting with only the Department of Sanskrit, it has grown into a multi-faculty University as one of the premier centres for advanced study and research in the region.

ABOUT DEPARTMENT OF HOLISTIC EDUCATION

The foundation of the Department of Holistic Education (DHE) is rooted in the ideology that education should extend beyond academic institutions. Vidya Bharti, the largest educational NGO globally, established a dedicated think tank Department comprising professionals from diverse fields such as academia, bureaucracy, higher and school education, society, scientists, and other experts like advocates and chartered accountants. It was started as a pilot project under Vidya Bharti Punjab. CONFERENCE VENUE AND LOCATION

About Kurukshetra: Known as the “Land of the Bhagavad Gita,” Kurukshetra is celebrated as the site of the Mahabharata and Lord Krishna’s teachings to Arjuna. The city’s spiritual heritage makes it a fitting backdrop for Shiksha Mahakumbh 2.0, merging educational and cultural exchange with a rich historical setting. The venue is easily accessible:

Air Travel: The nearest airports are Indira Gandhi International Airport (Delhi, 160 km) and Chandigarh Airport. Both offer taxi services to Kurukshetra.

Rail Travel: Kurukshetra Railway Station (Kurukshetra Junction) on the main Delhi-Ambala line is well connected to major cities, with the Shatabadi Express halting here. Key routes include:

- **Route 1:** Pehowa, Kaithal, Narwana, Jind – via Thanesar Station
- **Route 2:** Delhi, Sonipat, Panipat, Karnal – via Kurukshetra Station
- **Route 3:** Ambala, Shahbad – via Kurukshetra Station

Bus Travel: Haryana Roadways and other State Corporation buses connect Kurukshetra to cities like Delhi, Ambala, and Karnal. Pipli, 6 km from Kurukshetra, is a key stop on the Grand Trunk Road (NH-1). Local Transport: Buses, auto-rickshaws, and taxis are available within Kurukshetra.

ACCOMODATION

A limited number of rooms with shared accommodation are available in Hostels/Guest Houses of Kurukshetra University and Zonal Headquarters of Vidya Bharti @ Kurukshetra. 
